



Please restrict your child to boxes of 24 crayons; more than this is difficult for a first grader to manage in a school setting. Where we have requested more than one of the same item, such as crayons, one will be saved for the second half of the year. We appreciate your cooperation and support, and look forward to an exciting first grade year.
