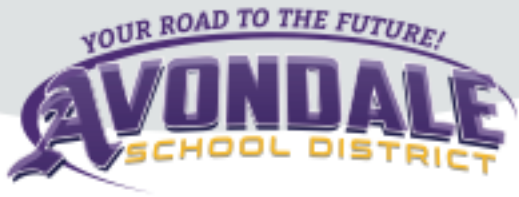


## R. Grant Graham First Grade Supply List

- 1 **Mead** brand wide-ruled composition notebook, 100 sheets. Stitched binding (no spiral), used for science instruction.
- 8 **Elmer's** glue sticks, 0.21 oz. size
- 1 box storage baggies
  - Last Name A-H: any brand zippered **GALLON** bags
  - Last Name I-P: any brand zippered **SANDWICH** bags
  - Last Name Q-Z: any brand zippered **SNACK** bags

Please bring these EXACT items to school on the first day.

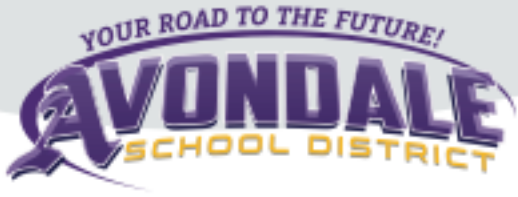


## R. Grant Graham Second Grade Supply List

These are suggested items each student will need to start the school year. Please bring these EXACT items to school on the first day.

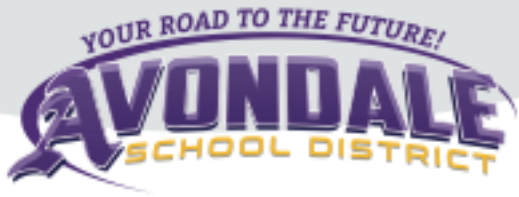

- Pencil holder (must be small)

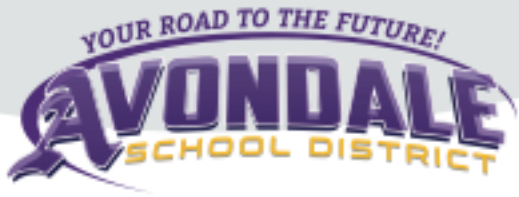
\*No rolling backpacks or Trapper Keepers. These items are difficult to store in the classroom.
