## Woodland Elementary School

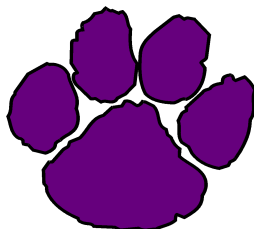
Although the school will furnish your child's educational materials, the items listed below are suggested supplies that will be useful to your child next year.

- 1 (8 count) Crayola Watercolor Paint Tray
- 1 - 2 Small Containers of Play Doh
- Pencil Box
- Headphones labeled with name
- Backpack labeled with name
- 1-2 containers of Disinfecting Wipes
- 1-2 Hand sanitizer
- 1-2 boxes of Kleenex
- Girls: Gallon sized storage bags
- Boys: Quart or sandwich sized storage bags

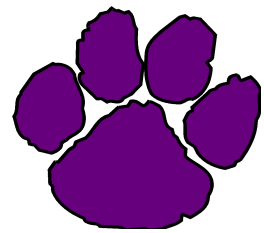
