**AMS Agenda is required in all classes daily.**

**English**

One 1½” 3-ring binder; 5 dividers; loose leaf paper; pencils; black or blue and red pens; highlighters; 1 package of post-it notes; 1 composition notebook; colored pencils

- ◆ Adv. English 7 reads: ***Waiting for Snow in Havana: Confessions of a Cuban Boy*** by Carlos Eire **OR** ***The Rocket Boys (also known as October Sky)*** by Homer Hickam, Jr. **(Every Advanced English student should bring completed study guide (available on AMS website) and book on the first day of school).**
- ◆ There is no required reading for English 7, however you are encouraged to enjoy a few novels of your choice over the summer.

**Math**

One 1½” 3-ring binder; 5 dividers; loose leaf paper; TI-30XIIS Calculator with your name written on it in permanent marker; pencils; pens; highlighters; pencil case

**Social Studies**

One 1½” 3-ring binder; 4 dividers; loose leaf paper; pencils; pens; colored pencils; highlighter; extra fine tip blue and black sharpies

**Science**

One 1½” or 2” 3-ring binder; dividers; pencils; pens; colored pencils (12 color assortment is sufficient); metric ruler; spiral notebook-single subject

**Exploratory Classes:**

- ◆ Art- 2 regular #2 pencils and a white eraser; 1 fine point & 1 extra fine point BLACK sharpie; colored pencils
- ◆ Advanced Art – See page 2
- ◆ Band- All Band Members must have a copy of Essential Techniques Book 3 by Tim Lautzenheizer, et al. (Hal Leonard Publishing), 101 Rhythm and Rest Patterns by Grover Yaus (Belwin Publishing), and Master Theory Book 1 by Charles Peters and Paul Yoder (Kjos Publishing). All three of these texts may be ordered through the band boosters in the fall or may be purchased ahead of time. Band members will need a folder or binder with paper for taking notes. All students will need to have a pencil every day. Woodwind players need a minimum of 3 playable reeds of strength 3 or higher. Brass players need to have appropriate valve oil and/or slide oil/grease. Trumpet and trombone players will need a straight mute and cup mute. Percussionists must have a stick bag, Timpani mallets (general use required, super staccato suggested in addition), Snare Sticks, Yarn Mallets, and Plastic Mallets. Band members must have an Avondale Bands polo shirt and khaki pants for uniform. Polo shirts can be purchased through the Avondale Band Boosters in the fall. **All band students need their own combination lock.**
- ◆ Careers- One spiral notebook, one folder
- ◆ Choir - One binder or folder, notebook specifically for choir notes; pencils
- ◆ Health- One folder, pencils, colored pencils
- ◆ Music Tech & Comp-USB flash drive of at least 2 GB (or other portable USB media equivalent for storing/transporting/backing up project files); headphones or earbuds; 1” binder with notebook paper for class notes, homework, project rubrics, etc.
- ◆ Spanish- One 1” 3-ring binder, 4 dividers, 1 dry erase marker, lined paper, pencils
- ◆ STEM – Duo Tang Folders with pockets, notebook, and economical pair of earbuds or headphones that can stay in class in a zip lock bag with student name on it
- ◆ Math Lab - One 1” 3-ring binder with 2 dividers, loose leaf paper, pens, pencils

**Additional Supplies:**

**All textbooks will need to have a book cover. A pencil pouch or case is also very helpful to carry materials to each class daily. Make sure your name is written on it in permanent marker.\*Please note:** Supply requests could be adjusted due to staffing changes.

The District will provide all basic supplies needed by the student to complete the required course curriculum. The student and/or his/her family may choose to purchase their own supplies if they desire to have a greater quantity or quality of supplies, or desire to help conserve the limited resources for use by others. The teacher or appropriate administrator may recommend useful supplies for these purposes.
