The Reading Clinic is for 1st – 12th grade. The **fee is \$300** (comparable services may run as high as \$2,000). Reading Clinics are conducted during the winter and summer semesters. Their goal is to identify your child's current reading strengths and needs and provide appropriate instruction to support your child's reading growth.
