While reading lower-level "just for fun" books or re-reading your favorite series is a good way to maintain reading habits, we recommend reading a few "challenge" books over the summer. We have included a list of books that are likely to meet students' challenge levels and we recommend that students read at least two new books from this list over the summer. The books you choose must be new to you. They cannot be books you have read before.

These suggested books will be available at all major book retailers such as Barnes & Noble or Amazon. You can also check many of them out at your public library. **Please note: we are <u>not</u> requiring a summer book report.**

The value in reading everyday:

Research shows that students that read over the summer maintain and improve upon their current reading skills and also score higher on standardized tests. In order to maintain/improve reading skills by moving to a higher level and to boost future test scores, we recommend reading over the summer. We also feel that reading independently will prepare students for the rigors of high school. With today's 21st Century being the Age of Information, reading comprehension and analysis skills are needed more than ever before!

- Utilize your Lexile Level range to help you determine an appropriate leveled book. This can be found in your last NWEA report. Please Note: you do not need to find a book that is in your Lexile range; Lexile is just one way to find a "just right" book.
- Select a book from a genre you don't normally read
- Visit the Young Adult Library Services Association (YALSA) website to launch the <u>Teen Book Finder Database</u> to help you get an idea of the different books listed.
